COVID-19 SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE

☐ Decrease/loss of sense of taste or smell

1.Do you have any of the following symptoms?	
☐ Fever and/or chills	☐ New cough / worsening chronic cough

☐ Unexplained fatigue, lethargy, malaise, or muscle aches

If YES, DO NOT ENTER. Notify your supervisor and go home. Follow directions of local public health authority. You may return to work if symptom-free for 24 hours and received a negative PCR test, or if symptoms relate to pre-existing condition or allergy.

2. Have you tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 10 days or been told to self isolate?

If YES, DO NOT ENTER. Notify your supervisor and go home. Follow directions of local public health authority.

3. Have you travelled outside of Canada, in the last 14 days? If YES, DO NOT ENTER. Notify your supervisor and go home.

VACCINATED? Individuals who are fully vaccinated 14 days or more ago are not required to self-isolate and may return to work with a negative PCR test unless otherwise directed by public health official. If symptoms start, you must stay home and get a COVID test.

4. Have you been in close contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19, within the last 14 days?

If YES, DO NOT ENTER. Notify your supervisor and go home.

VACCINATED? Individuals who are fully vaccinated 14 days or more ago are not required to self-isolate and may return to work with a negative PCR test unless otherwise directed by public health official. If symptoms start, you must stay home and get a COVID test.

Vaccinated is defined as any individual >14 days after receiving their second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or their first dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine series (i.e. Johnson and Johnson)?
